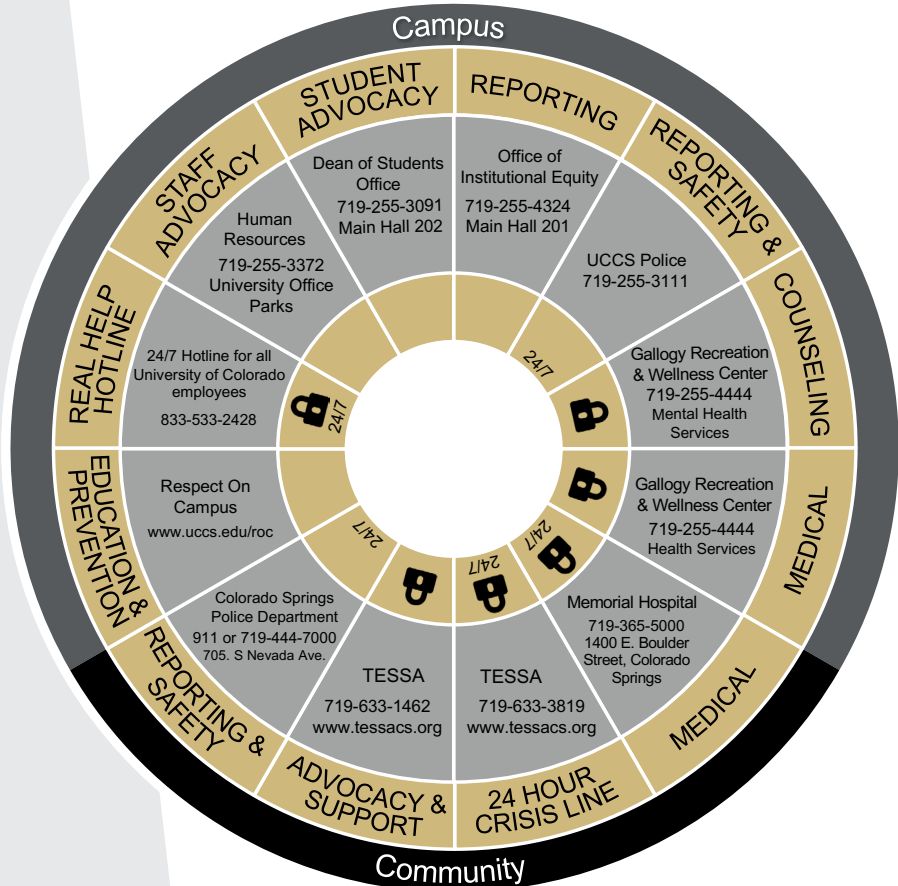


## YOUR KEY TO CRITICAL SUPPORT NETWORKS
